ANNOUNCEMENT – EMSAN DAY SYMPOSIUM

20 November 2021

A One-Day Symposium will be organised at **Shenzhen University** on **Saturday, November 20, 2021.** Any topic involving electronic music will be considered. Students are strongly encouraged to participate and propose a communication. Because the event takes place in at Shenzhen university, it is an opportunity for graduate students to make a presentation and engage in a dialog with the audience.

Examples of relevant topics:

- Electronic music trends in Asia
- Composition for Asian instruments and electronics
- Building of synthesizers in Asia
- Use of electronic sounds in Film music
- Famous electronic music composers in Asia
- Dance with electronic music compositions
- Dance with interactive systems
- Analysis of an electronic music piece, including mixed music (instruments and electronic sounds)
- The electronic music situation in Asia: education, concerts, diffusion, gender questions

Proposals should be sent to <u>marcb@szu.edu.cn</u> before October 15. Any topic involving electronic music will be considered. Communications with audio or video examples are encouraged. Presentations are 20 minutes. Because it is an international conference, it is preferable to give presentations in English. However, presentations in other languages, such as Chinese or Japanese, are possible; in this case, prepare the slides in English for the audience.

The event is organised by EMSAN (Electroacoustic Music Studies Asia Network) and Shenzhen University, College of Arts, Department of Music and Dance.

EMSAN meetings have been organised almost every year since 2008. They often take place during the Musicacoustica Festival at the Beijing Central Conservatory, but have also been held in Taipei, Tokyo and Gifu (Japan).

Some of the presentations will be considered for publication in 2022 by the international journal *Organised Sound* (Cambridge University Press), in the special issue "Electronic Music in China Today".

The event requires that participants register in advance. Participation is free.
